- **a.** A list of all the informal and/or non-formal learning you have obtained, including courses, workshops, etc.
- b. Your skills and knowledge gained from your completed course/ work-related experience and how these relate to your Murdoch course.

TIP: You need to be very specific with this statement, as your Academic Chair must extensively match with your experience and to the learning objectives and outcomes in each unit you are seeking as advanced standing.

You may contact the Unit Coordinator of the unit you are seeking as advanced standing for to obtain a copy of the Unit Informational Learning Guide in order to ascertain the learning objectives and outcomes.

 - **b.** Position titles and length of service
 - Referee names and contact details of a manager/supervisor who can substantiate your claims

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The Assessment Process

Upon receipt of your completed Request for Advanced Standing (Informal/Non-Formal Learning) Form and your supporting documents, the Accreditation and Advanced Standing Officer will forward your request to the relevant Academic Chair to be formally assessed. Please note that:

- a.The Academic Chair may require you to sit for an assessment (Theoritical and/or Practical) and/or a test prior to making a decision;
- b. Additional information or clarity may be required from you;
- c. Under normal circumstances, the application process make take up to, or more than, four weeks;
- d. Students seeking advanced standing for one or more currently enrolled units must contact their Academic Chair before the census date.
- e. The final outcome must be presented to the Accreditation and Advanced Standing Officer to ensure that your advanced standing is awarded to your study record;
- f. The Academic Chair and the Accreditation and Advanced Standing cannot award more than 50% of your Part II core units as advanced standing.

- 2. I have supplied Murdoch University with a Statement of Criteria with each individual unit I am requesting for advanced standing.
- I understand that providing incomplete or incorrect documents will result in my assessment of advanced standing being delayed or incorrect.

- **7.** I understand that my advanced standing can only be assessed after an offer, conditional offer or package offer has been sent to me.
